Booking / Photo Shoot Checklist

The following is a **suggested** checklist of items to bring to bookings and photo shoots. It is recommended that you check with your photographer and/or booking agent or manager beforehand to discuss specific items not listed that may be required. The outfits worn and the types of photos comprising a shoot are ultimately the choice of the model. Let your photographer know what you prefer and **never** submit to being photographed in any way that makes you uncomfortable or fails to fulfill your requirements. Remember, it's **your** shoot and you have every right to influence how it is conducted.

- ___ 1. **Pantyhose** to include: nude or suntan sheer-to-waist sandalfoot, as well as black sandalfoot.
- ___ 2. **Assorted swimsuits** in a variety of styles and colors.
- ___ 3. **Assorted outfits** to include: tops, shorts, casual and formal attire.
- ___ 4. **Underarm protectors** to prevent stains and deodorant from soiling garments.
- ___ 5. **Scarf** to tie over your head when changing outfits to prevent makeup from soiling garments.
- ___ 6. **Hair supplies:** Comb, brush, hair pins, bobby pins, coated rubber bands, barrettes, hair combs, hairspray, mousse, curling iron, electric rollers, and blow dryer.
- ___ 7. **Shoes:** A supply of shoes, depending on season, location and type of shoot or booking. Shoes should be neutral tones with delicate styling that don't compete with what you're wearing. Assortment should include closed pumps, strap high-heeled evening sandals, and delicate daytime shoes. Include boots during winter and leather shoes for fall daytime wear. For summer include tennis shoes, sandals, ballet slippers, and flats. For glamour shoots include black and white heels.
- ___ 8. **Smock or robe** for in-between outfit changes and breaks.
- ___ 9. **Assorted Jewelry:** Bracelets, earrings, watch, rings and necklaces.
- ___ 10. **Assorted Accessories:** Belts, glasses, scarves, ties, wraps.
- ___ 11. **Nails supplies:** Polish (clear, red and colors to complement the clothes you will be wearing), files, polish remover, clippers, nail polish dryer (spray-on type).
- ___ 12. **Makeup:** Bring a large assortment and be prepared for any changes you may need to make in colors and/or shading. Include the following items: foundation, eye and lip pencils, eye shadow (light, medium, dark & iridescent), brushes, makeup remover, eye drops, concealer, mascara, lipstick (2 colors including a dark color for B&W photos), eyeliner, cotton swabs, tissues, tweezers, translucent powder, eye makeup for touchups, blush, lip gloss, moisturizer and mirror.
- ___ 13. **Emergency items:** Needle and thread, safety pins, scissors, straight pins, double-sided tape, scotch tape, razor, panty liners, and feminine sanitary products.
- ___ 14. **Music and Beverage:** If possible, bring with you a sample of your favorite music and a beverage that you like, or let your photographer or booking agent know your preferences so that these items can be made available for you during your shoot or booking.
